

ODUNAYO CLEMENT ADEBOOYE



Odunayo Clement Adebooye, a Nigerian, is the Director of Research and Linkages at the Osun State University, Osogbo-Nigeria and also the Ambassador Scientist of the Germany Humboldt Foundation. Adebooye is a Professor of Agronomy/Plant Physiology and a holder of PhD from the University of Ibadan, Nigeria. He also holds Certificate in Tissue Culture techniques (United Nations University, Tokyo), Certificate in Cytogenetics (IITA, Ibadan) and Certificate in Food and Plant Analysis (United Nations/CSIR, India).

He is a Fellow of the College of Research Associates (CRA), United Nations University, Tokyo, Japan. Adebooye had postdoctoral research experience at the United Nations University, CFTRI, Mysore, India. He also worked as an Alexander von Humboldt (AvH) Foundation Research Fellow at the University of Bonn, Germany. He has severally served as Visiting Professor at the University of Bonn and University of Hohenheim, Germany. He has also served as PhD external examiner at the University of Fort Hare, South Africa as well as project assessor for DANIDA, Denmark. He is an alumnus of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), Germany. Adebooye has won 10 competitive research grants (United Nations; The World Academy of Science, Italy; CSIR, India; Humboldt Foundation, Germany; DAAD, Germany; Canadian IDRC; Canadian DFATD etc) and attended about 70 international conferences in about 20 countries. Adebooye was named as the first Nigerian to win the German Humboldt Alumni Award in 2009 by the German Government's Humboldt Foundation. Prof. Adebooye is also one of the founding members of the African-German Network for Excellence in Sciences (AGNES), which is being fully supported by the German Alexander von Humboldt Foundation. Adebooye is Principal Investigator on the IDRC-DFATD funded (CISFRF) project on the indigenous vegetables of Nigeria. In 2014, he was awarded the "Southwest Nigeria Man of the Year Award" because of the impact he made on the livelihood of the poor rural farmers through the implementation of the CISFRF project. He is a member of some high-profile professional organizations including the International Society for Horticultural Science, German Society for Horticultural Science, Japanese Society for Horticultural Science and Indian Society of Food Technologists. In Nigeria, Adebooye is one of the major formulators of the Osun State School Feeding Policy which is being implemented till today. Adebooye has published relevant papers in a number of high impact scientific journals on the conservation, production and physiology of indigenous Nigerian vegetables.
